A message from SOS Chair Paul Khan...

Hi All.

I hope you are all well.

I must start with the announcement from LFC that there will be a price freeze for all general admission and season tickets for the 2025/26 season.

We need to say a massive thank you for all your support. Without 92.1% of members providing us with a mandate to approach the club to engage in meaningful engagement this price freeze would not have been possible.

And, I want to say a massive thank you to the Management Committee for all the challenging work in developing a negotiation strategy that helped deliver this price freeze. Also, big thanks to our friends on the Supporters Board - Spion Kop 1906, Official Liverpool Supporters Group, Liverpool Women Supporters Club, Kop Outs and cultureRed - an independent organisation representing and uniting Faith, Culture and Ethnicity - who supported us throughout the process.

Some may say we did not achieve our primary objective of a reduction in ticket prices. But this is a start and we will continue to work with the club over the coming year to try and make this happen. For full details of our response to the price freeze, see here.

Our support for the national *Stop Exploiting Loyalty* campaign will remain. We need to stand in solidarity with other fan groups as they continue their fight for fairer ticket prices and stopping the removal of concessions.

Again, thank you, because the SEL campaign would not have happened without your mandate to raise the issue of ticket prices at the Football Supporters' Association AGM. Your support has helped generate a national initiative, helping put aside tribal loyalties. You should be proud.

On the field we are still in a great position in the league, have the Carabao Cup Final to look forward to and obviously the resumption of the Champions League. We need to really get behind the team in these final months and I hope we can achieve great things together.
